

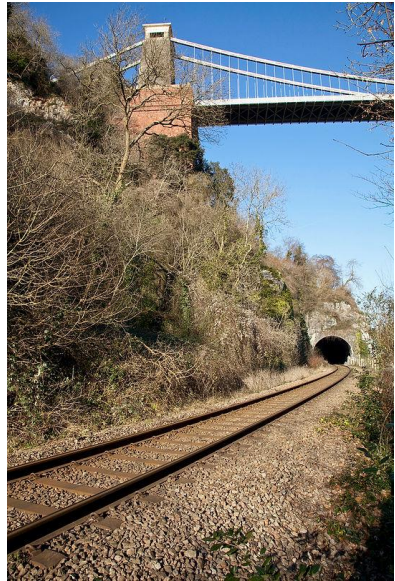
RAILS IN THE AVON GORGE
